RESOLUTION

OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS TO SUPPORT THE LAS VEGAS VALLEY WATER DISTRICT'S FILING OF APPLICATIONS FOR THE UNAPPROPRIATED WATER IN CLARK, LINCOLN, NYE, AND WHITE PINE COUNTIES.

WHEREAS; the City of Las Vegas finds that the natural growth of the population and the limited supply of water in Clark County made the conservation of water resources and securing new water resources vital to ensure future prosperity, health and safety of the County and thereby the State; and

WHEREAS; analyses of our water supply indicate that even with conservation, current water supplies will not be sufficient to meet future demands.

WHEREAS; the Las Vegas Valley Water District and Clark County, in cooperation with local governmental agencies, business and private citizens, are participating in comprehensive conservation programs in order to optimize our current water supply until new resources become available; and

WHEREAS; the Las Vegas Valley Water District and Clark County desire to develop this project in cooperation with the other Counties,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Las Vegas does hereby support the Las Vegas Valley Water District's filing of applications for unappropriated water in Clark, Lincoln, Nye, and White Pine Counties.
