WHEREAS, the transportation needs of Clark County include, among others, the categories of regional and neighborhood streets, state and federal highways, resort corridors, mass transit, beltways and airport access; and

WHEREAS, transportation improvements will enhance the social and economic well being of Southern Nevada residents; and


WHEREAS, the goal of public transportation in any given metropolitan area is to provide access to major arteries, facilities or to other means of transportation within city and county limits; and


WHEREAS, there currently is no form of bus transportation which provides transportation from the downtown area to McCarran International Airport; and

WHEREAS, according to NRS 373.117, the Clark County Regional Transportation Commission has the authority to establish or operate a system of bus transportation consisting of regular routes and fixed schedules to serve the public, and may lease vehicles to or from, or enter into other contracts with a private operator for the provision of a system of public transit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Las Vegas encourages the Clark County Regional Transportation Commission to provide bus service from the Downtown Transportation Center to McCarran International Airport and urges all citizens of the City of Las Vegas and Clark County to join in this support.
