

RESOLUTION

HIGH PRESSURE NATURAL GAS TRANSMISSION LINE
THROUGH THE LAS VEGAS VALLEY

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WHEREAS, Kern River and WyCal have both proposed to locate their gas transmission pipelines in the developing North and Northwesterly portions of the Las Vegas Valley; and

WHEREAS, the proposed pipeline route will travel through the incorporated limits of the City of Las Vegas and the City of North Las Vegas, as well as the unincorporated limits of Clark County; and

WHEREAS, both pipeline companies have indicated that they are willing to locate the pipeline in an area satisfactory to the local governments if the change does not cause a construction delay; and


WHEREAS, the City of North Las Vegas and the County of Clark have agreed to an amendment of the Grand Teton route along an existing electrical transmission corridor;

NOW, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Las Vegas endorses and supports the pipeline companies in their efforts to develop alternate federal pipeline routes from the existing federally-approved alignment along Centennial Parkway to our first-preferred alignment along Grand Teton Drive. This first-preferred route would run along Grand Teton Drive from the federal alignment at about Hollywood Boulevard westerly to Pecos Road, then continuing west along Grand Teton within the 90 foot wide easement granted to Nevada Power Company and designated N-42592 by the Bureau of Land arrangement of the U.S. Department of the Interior to Decatur Boulevard, then north along Decatur Boulevard to within the same easement to Moccasin Road, then west along Moccasin Road to Hualpai Way within the same easement, and then south along Hualpai Road to the federal alignment at Ann Road.




1 The City's second-preferred alignment would run along Grand Teton Drive
