

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, various sections of TITLE 11 of the Las Vegas Municipal Code allow for additions to and corrections of the schedules which are established in the respective sections to be effected by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined and recommended by the Traffic and Parking Commission and the Traffic Engineer that the following additions and corrections be made in said schedules; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, that the following schedules pertaining to TITLE 11 of the City Code be amended as follows:


Schedule 25-II be amended to delete the following 35 MPH Speed Limit:

- On Lake Mead Boulevard from Buffalo Drive to Town Center Drive
- On Cheyenne Avenue from Buffalo Drive to the westerly City limits
- On Owens Avenue from the Las Vegas Wash to Nellis Boulevard

Schedule 25-IV be amended to include the following 45 MPH Speed Limit:

- On Lake Mead Boulevard from Buffalo Drive to Town Center Drive
- On Cheyenne Avenue from Buffalo Drive to the westerly City limits
- On Owens Avenue from the Las Vegas Wash to Nellis Boulevard

PASSED, ADOPTED, AND APPROVED this 16th day of January, 1991.



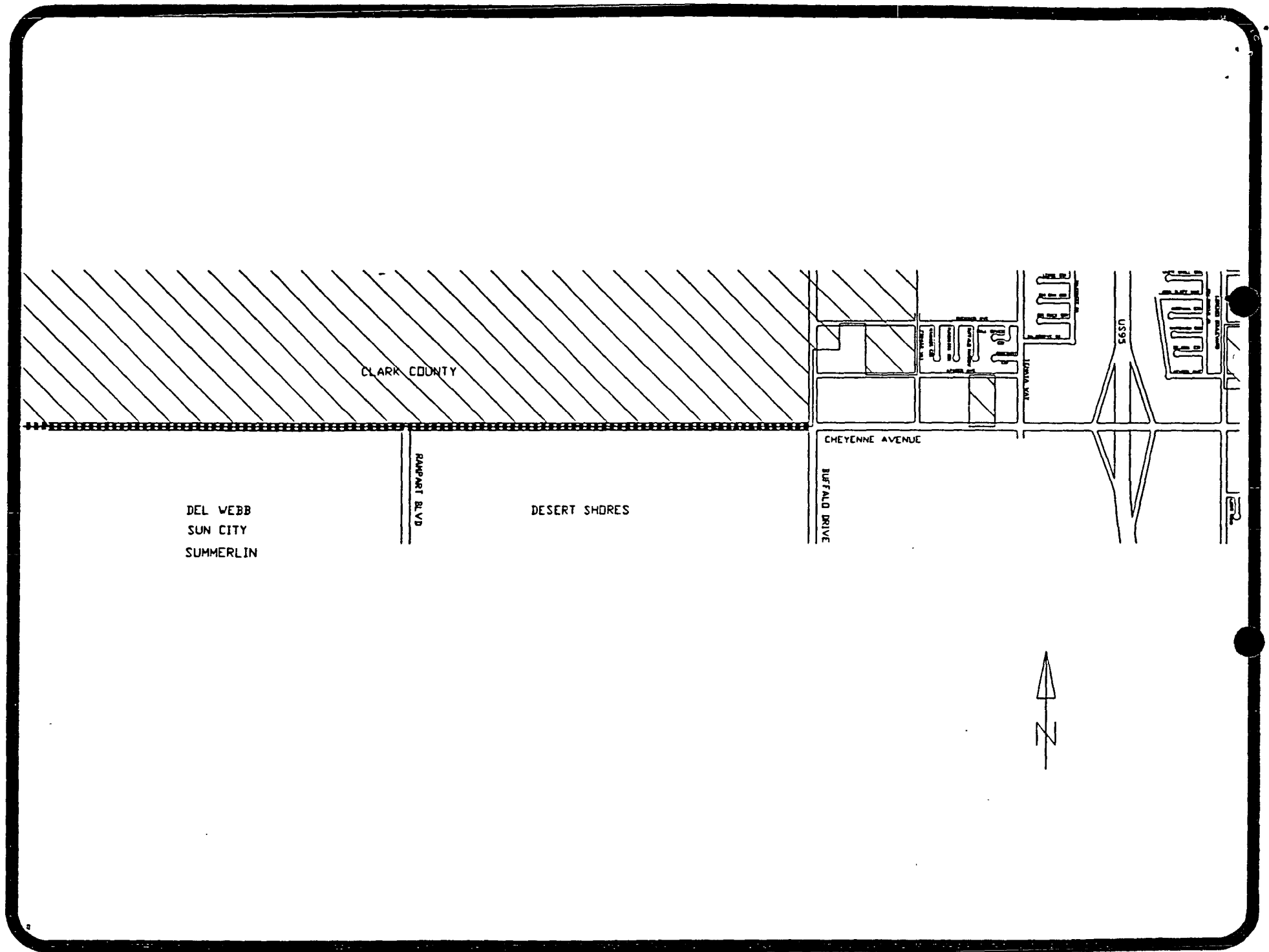

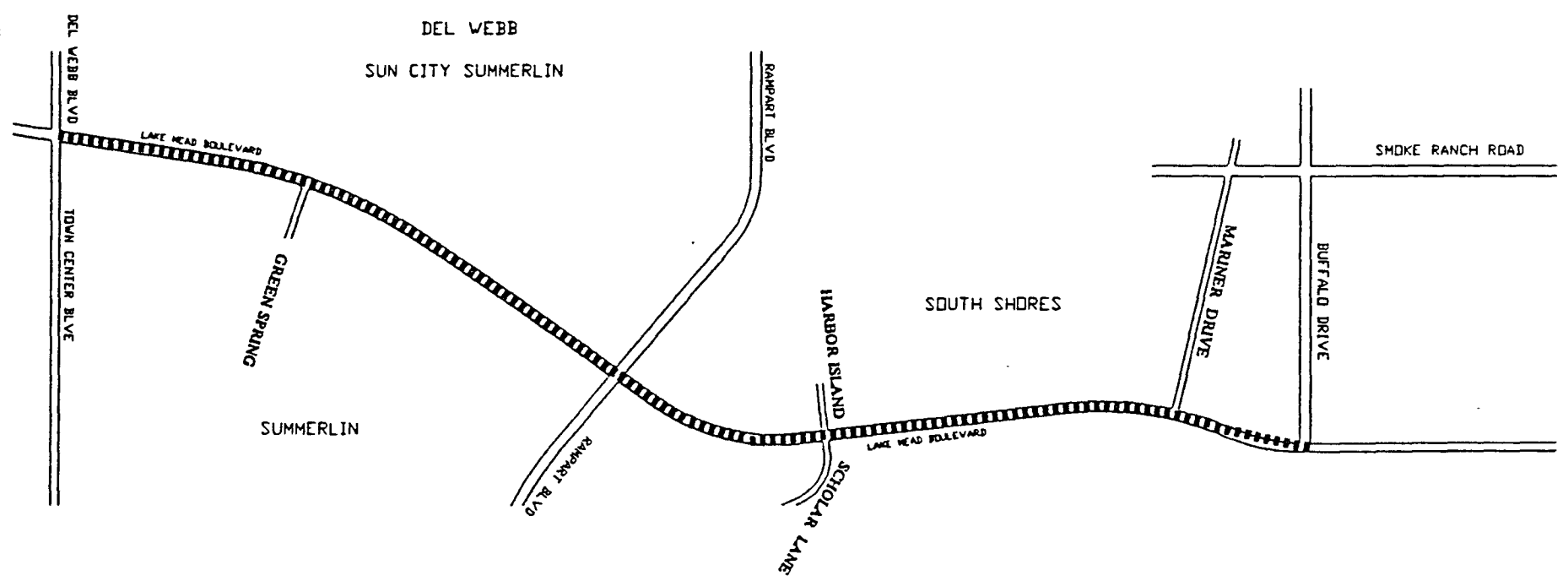

SUBJECT: **CHANGE SPEED LIMIT ON CHEYENNE AVENUE**

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND

Staff is requesting an increase in the speed limit on Cheyenne Avenue from Buffalo Drive to the westerly City limits from 35 mph to 45 mph. Recent speed surveys show 85th percentile speeds of 54 mph. Half street roadway improvements are completed on the south side of Cheyenne Avenue for 2.5 miles adjacent to the Desert Shores and Sun City subdivisions. Screening walls and a drainage ditch are in place along this entire stretch and Rampart Boulevard is the only intersection.


ISCAL IMPACT

City personnel will install the speed limit signs. Funds are available in the F/Y 1990-91 budget.

RECOMMENDATIONS

TRAFFIC AND PARKING COMMISSION: Recommends increasing the speed limit to 45 mph on Cheyenne Avenue from Buffalo Drive to the westerly City limits, and that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Resolution.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Approval
