

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, through the Better Public Service Program, the City of Las Vegas has worked effectively with other local governmental entities in Southern Nevada to produce uniform regulations and identify new ways in which cooperative efforts between local governments can provide better services to citizens; and

WHEREAS, through the efforts of this program, cooperative efforts have resulted in a regional water conservation plan, numerous uniform building code standards, and proposed joint standards and projects in the areas of fire, survey, parks, and business license; and

WHEREAS, the investigation of opportunities to regionalize service delivery to the citizens of Southern Nevada will be based on the principles of cost efficiency, service effectiveness, and customer benefit; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Board of Commissioners has requested that the City of Las Vegas continue to pursue and investigate additional means to provide the highest quality of services possible to the citizens of Clark County; and

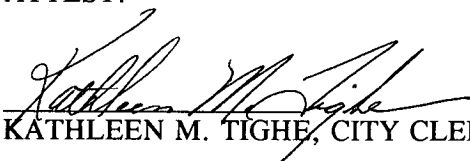
WHEREAS, the Clark County Fire Department and the City of Las Vegas Fire Department operate under a uniform fire code, utilize a central alarm office, and cooperate closely through Mutual Aid Agreements, joint training, and equipment inspection and maintenance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Las Vegas City Council will support the continuing efforts between the City of Las Vegas and Clark County to investigate opportunities to regionalize service delivery to the citizens of Southern Nevada; 2) such investigations will be based on the principles of cost efficiency, service effectiveness, and customer benefit; and 3) initial efforts focus on the creation of unified fire protection services.
