RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE EFFORTS OF THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE UNITED STATES IN THE MIDDLE EAST CRISIS

WHEREAS, the Iraqi government has invaded and annexed the Country of Kuwait against their wishes; and

WHEREAS, the action has precipitated a negative reaction by most of the nations of the world; and

WHEREAS, the United Nations has acted to condemn this invasion of Kuwait and to seek Iraqi withdrawal from this sovereign territory; and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States, the Secretary-General of the United Nations and many other international political and religious leaders have attempted to secure peaceful solutions to this problem without success; and

WHEREAS, the Iraqi leadership has consistently held that they have no intention of withdrawing their occupation of Kuwait; and


WHEREAS, an appropriate time period set by the United Nations for Iraqi withdrawal has since expired; and


WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has supported the use of necessary and essential force to aid and assist in returning the Kuwait government to its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, does hereby resolve:

1. That the City Council of the City of Las Vegas fully supports the actions of the United Nations, the President and Congress of the United States.
2. That the City Council calls upon all citizens to support these efforts and prays for an early solution to these aggressive actions in the most peaceful method possible.
3. That all nations support the actions of our military and civilian forces in the middle east in our international attempt to return the government of Kuwait to its citizens.
4. That copies of this proclamation be forwarded to the Secretary-General of the United Nations; the President of the United States and the Nevada Congressional delegation

He stated that Councilman Nolen and he were going to make a presentation before the Las Vegas Convention Visitors Authority and at that time will know how much the city's responsibility will be. He asked for this to be referred to the City Manager and be brought back at the 2/20/91 meeting. He stated the City should support the NCL, but was concerned about the amount that should be put into the resolution.

CITY MANAGER WILLIAM NOONAN stated that dialogue had already been opened wth the Director of NLC with those very issues and would be meeting with his key staff.
