

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, by enacting Chapter 4.24 of the Municipal Code of said City, imposed, for the purpose of generating funds with which to finance recreational facilities within the corporate boundaries of said City, an impact fee upon the construction of all apartment houses and residential dwelling units that are constructed within said City on and after February 1, 1989; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 80 of said Chapter, the City is divided into eleven park districts, as the same are depicted on the map that is entitled "Park District Boundaries" which is now on file in the Office of the City Clerk and the Department of Parks and Leisure Activities; and

WHEREAS, said Section 80 provides that said map may be amended from time to time in order to modify the boundaries of the several park districts by a resolution that is duly passed, adopted and approved by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, said City Council has determined, and by this Resolution does so determine, that the boundaries of Park District No. 09 and Park District No. 10, as the same are designated on said map, should be combined, thereby reducing the total number of Park Impact Fee Districts from eleven to ten; and to change the designation of the Park Impact Fee Districts from numerals to letters; and that said map should be amended accordingly;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, at its regular meeting held on




Wednesday, February 20, 1991, that Park District No. 09 and Park District No. 10 be and they hereby are, combined, thereby reducing the total number of Park Impact Fee Districts from eleven to ten; and that the designations of the Park Impact Fee Districts be and they hereby are changed from numerals to letters.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said map be, and the same hereby is, ordered to be amended to reflect such combination and change; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of said map, as so amended, be filed forthwith in the Office of the City Clerk and in the Department of Parks and Leisure Activities.



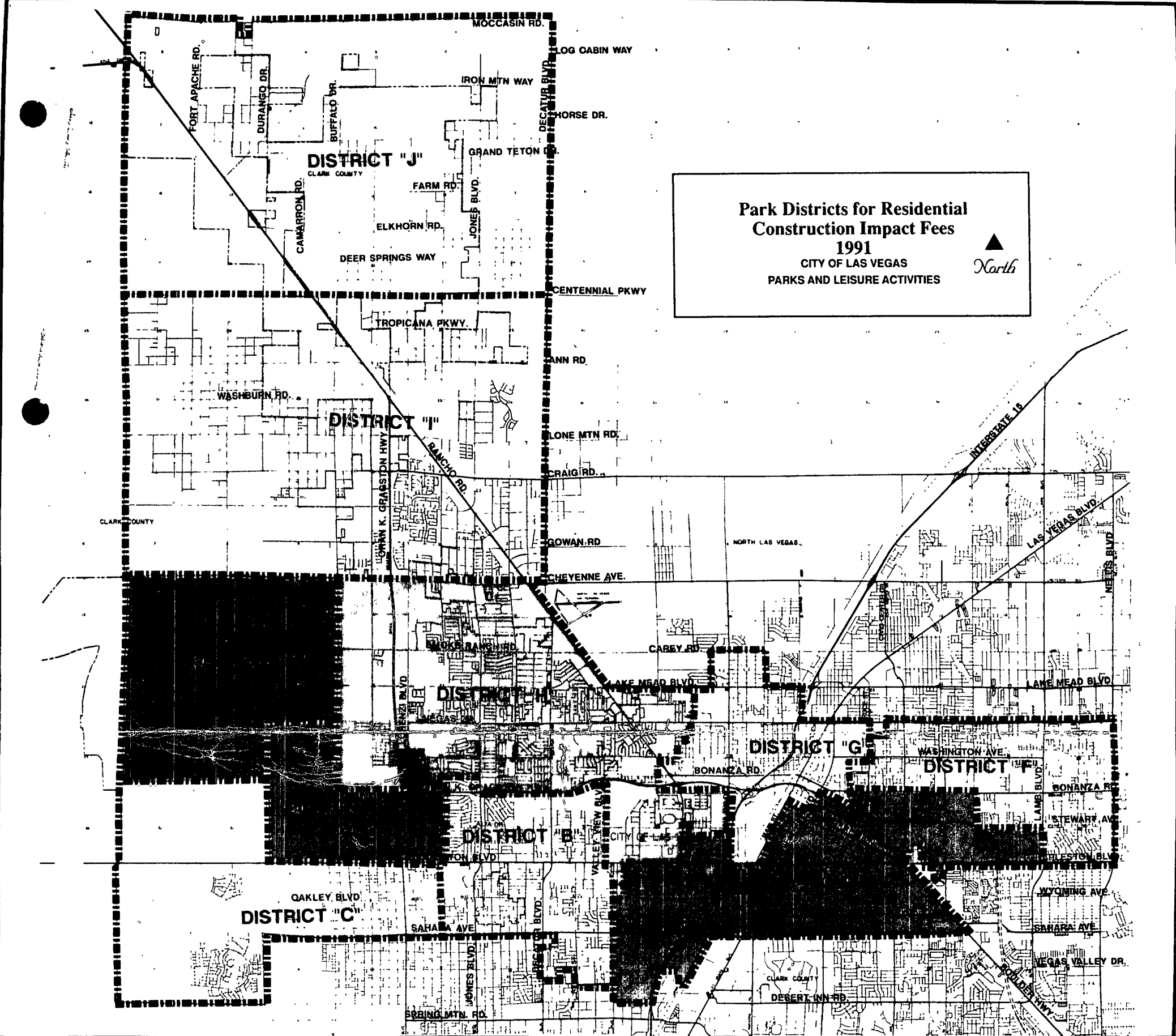

SUBJECT: Resolution to amend Park Districts to combine District 09 and 10, and to change the designations of the Park Districts from numerals to letters.

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND

The City does not own, nor does BLM have any property available in District 9 for park development. The combination of these districts (09 and 10) will enable the Department of Parks and Leisure Activities to start development on the Torrey Pines Park project and will free funding for other projects within the boundaries of the combined park districts.

The Parks and Leisure Activities Department has met with the Southern Nevada Homebuilders representative and has received the organization's approval for this proposed change.

To eliminate any possible confusion due to the change in numbers, the districts will be identified with alphabetical letter designations after the change. The changes in designation are as follows:
