

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA TO DESIGNATE
THE MOULIN ROUGE HOTEL AND CASINO AS A
LANDMARK IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS PURSUANT
TO ORDINANCE NO. 3557

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3 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Las Vegas finds and declares that
4 the spirit and direction of the City of Las Vegas are founded upon and reflected
5 in its historical past; and

6 WHEREAS, the historic and cultural foundations of the City should be
7 preserved as a living part of its community life and development in order to
8 give a sense of identity and orientation to the people of Las Vegas; and

9 WHEREAS, the City Council desires to safeguard the heritage of the City
10 of Las Vegas by preserving buildings, structures, places, sites and districts
11 which reflect the elements of its cultural, social, economic, political or
12 architectural history; and

13 WHEREAS, the City Council desires to strengthen the local economy by
14 promoting tourist interest in buildings, structures, places, sites and districts
15 of cultural and architectural significance; and

16 WHEREAS, the City Council desires to promote the preservation of historic
17 and architectural resources for the education, welfare and pleasure of the
18 residents of the City; and

19 WHEREAS, the City Council provided the mechanism to accomplish the above
20 by adopting Ordinance No. 3557 on February 20, 1991 and appointing the City of
21 Las Vegas Historic Preservation Commission on March 6, 1991; and

22 WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas Historic Preservation Commission has as one
23 of its duties to identify potential landmarks and to recommend to the City
24 Council the designation of such landmarks pursuant to Ordinance No. 3557; and

25 WHEREAS, in accordance with Ordinance No. 3557, the City of Las Vegas
26 Historic Preservation Commission has identified the Moulin Rouge Hotel and
27 Casino as a potential Landmark and has conducted a public hearing regarding
28 same; and

29 WHEREAS, the Commission has voted to recommend to the City Council that
30 the Moulin Rouge Hotel and Casino be designated as a Landmark because it
31 exemplifies or reflects special elements of the City's cultural, social,
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2 economic, political, aesthetic, engineering or architectural past and is
3 identifiable with persons or events significant in local history.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Las
5 Vegas, Nevada, that:

6 1. Based upon the recommendation of the Historic Preservation Commission,
7 the City Council finds that the property identified in Paragraph 2 qualifies
8 for designation as a Landmark pursuant to Ordinance No. 3557 because it is of
9 exceptional significance, is not unsound, dangerous or defective, and it
10 exemplifies or reflects special elements of the City's cultural, social,
11 economic, political, aesthetic, engineering or architectural past and is
12 identifiable with persons or events significant in local history.

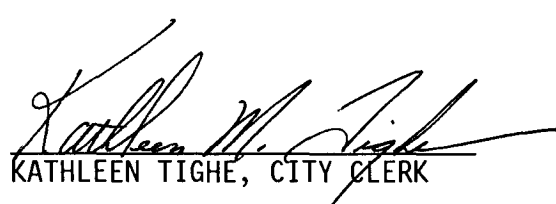
13 2. The following property, therefore, is hereby designated as a Landmark:

14 **MOULIN ROUGE HOTEL AND CASINO**
