**RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING 1992 STATE CEILING OF
THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, TO CLARK COUNTY,
NEVADA, FOR CERTAIN PROJECTS.**

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas, Nevada (the "City") has been advised that Clark County, Nevada (the "County") has been requested to undertake proceedings in connection with the issuance of its revenue bonds (the "Bonds") pursuant to the County Economic Development Revenue Bond Law (the "Act") to finance facilities for the manufacturing of plastic liners and other items within the County (the "Project") for Serrot Corporation (the "Company"); and

WHEREAS, Section 146 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Internal Revenue Code"), imposes an annual dollar limit (the "State Ceiling") on the amount of private activity bonds (which, as defined therein, would include the Bonds) which can be issued in each state, the interest on which is exempt from federal income taxes; and

WHEREAS, Section 146 of the Internal Revenue Code provides that each state may determine the method by which its State Ceiling for each year is to be allocated among the issuers of the state; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Chapter 348A of the Nevada Revised Statutes, as amended (the "Allocation Act"), and Regulations thereunder adopted by the Director of the Department of Commerce (respectively, the "Director" and the "Allocation Regulations"), Nevada's State Ceiling for 1988 and each year thereafter is allocated 50% to the Director and 50% to local governments, and the local governments' share is allocated between cities and counties on the basis of population (which in the case of counties is the population of the unincorporated areas of the counties); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Allocation Act and the Allocation Regulations, the Director has determined that the City's share of the Nevada State Ceiling for 1992 is \$16,839,911; and

WHEREAS, the City has transferred \$10,000,000 of its allocation to the County for the benefit of Nevada Power Company ("Nevada Power"); and

WHEREAS, the City has been requested to transfer its remaining \$6,839,911 of its allocated share of the State Ceiling for 1992 to the County to be applied to the Bonds for the purpose of financing the Project for the Company, and such transfer is authorized and permitted by the Allocation Act and the Allocation Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates that it will be unable to utilize such portion of its State Ceiling for 1992, and the City will incur no cost or liability in connection with the issuance of the Bonds.

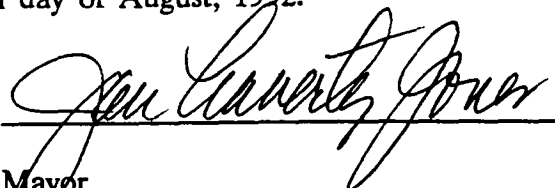
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby transfers to Clark County, Nevada, the remaining portion of its 1992 State Ceiling in the amount of \$6,839,911 to be applied to the Bonds to finance the Project for the Company, provided that such Bonds are issued on or before December 15, 1992. If such Bonds are not issued at that time, such allocation shall remain with the County, but shall be used by the County for a project for the local furnishing of electricity for Nevada Power.

Section 2. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to file or cause to be filed a certified copy of this resolution with the County Clerk of the County, the Director and the Secretary of the State Board of Finance within five days after the date of adoption of this resolution.

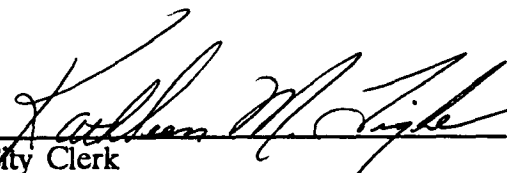
Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.

Thereupon, after considering other matters not concerning financing of the of a project for Serrot Corporation, upon motion duly made, and adopted, such meeting was adjourned.

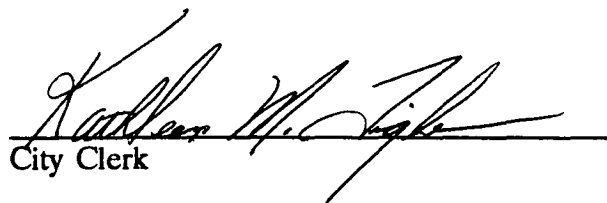

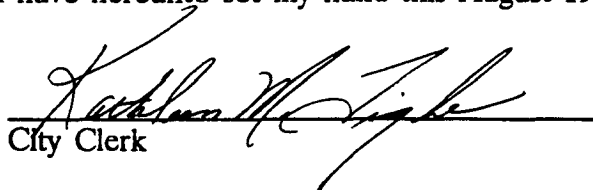

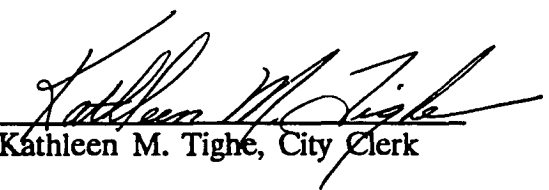
