

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, it has been the custom in the City of Las Vegas to memorialize by a parade on Veterans Day, November 11th, the services rendered by the men and women of the Armed Forces of the United States of America during the periods in which our country has been involved in combat against the oppressors of freedom and democracy throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, the Veterans Day Parade of November 11, 1991, was highlighted by the marching high school bands and high school ROTC units representing the finest youth of the community; and the Veterans of World War II, Korea, Vietnam and Desert Storm; all of whom were enthusiastically applauded by a tremendous crowd of people of all ages who lined the parade route,

WHEREAS, the responsibility for planning and organizing the parade has been assumed by a Veterans Day Parade Committee composed of citizens representing the various veterans and affiliated organizations, and

WHEREAS, the Committee incurs incidental expenses for postage, insurance and refreshments for parade participants, which expenses are partially covered by donations from individuals and businessmen who consider it a patriotic and community duty to honor its veterans, living and deceased, and

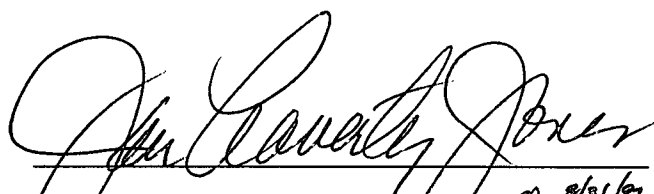
WHEREAS, the veterans and affiliated organizations are non-profit entities unable to underwrite the major expenses of planning and organizing the parade, such as the expense of overtime for police personnel involved in directing traffic and maintaining order along the parade route, the rental of highway signs for controlling traffic movements in and out of the assembly areas and the cost of the sanitation cleanup of the parade route after the parade, and

WHEREAS, the successful 1991 parade would not have taken place except for the generosity of a downtown casino owner who, for the second year, supplied the necessary funding.

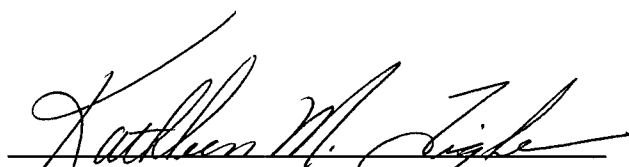


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, that 1992 City budget and future budgets include funding in the amount of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for expenses related to police officer overtime, highway rental signs, parade insurance and sanitation cleanup incurred by the Veterans Day Parade Committee for the annual Veterans Day Parade.
