**A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT A PROPOSAL SUBMITTED TO THE
U. S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT
FOR THE ACQUISITION OF HUD-OWNED HOMES IN WEST LAS VEGAS
FOR REHABILITATION AND JOB TRAINING**

WHEREAS, it is the mission of the City of Las Vegas, through economic empowerment, to provide affordable housing programs to low- and moderate-income families located in disadvantaged neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Las Vegas City Council is concerned about affordable housing plans for disadvantaged communities in the Las Vegas Valley; and

WHEREAS, the Las Vegas Valley has several communities whose residents average income and housing conditions are below the average metropolitan area standards; and

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas is strongly committed to addressing urban blight and community empowerment through affordable housing;

LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Las Vegas City Council supports the joint partnership among the Department of Housing and Urban Development, Nevada Business Services, private financial institutions and the City of Las Vegas to provide economic empowerment through affordable housing.

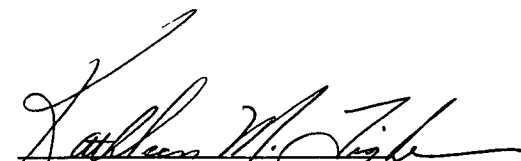
