

RESOLUTION REGARDING POLICY FOR USE OF
PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENTS FOR PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

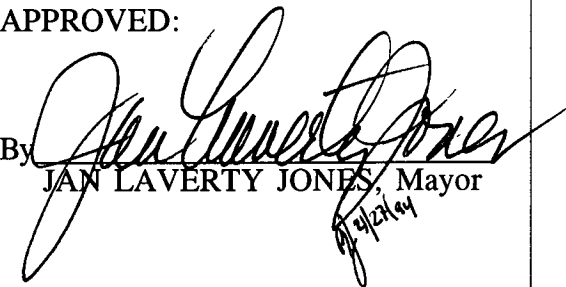
WHEREAS, the use of Project Labor Agreements on public construction work has proved to be beneficial to the owners and developers of Public Projects, and

WHEREAS, Project Labor Agreements on Public Construction Work also benefit the public served by: (A) maximizing employment opportunities for local residents on local projects; (B) making available a ready and adequate supply of highly trained and skilled craft workers; (C) providing an effective and efficient job that can be completed on time and within budget; and (D) assuring labor stability and peace over the life of the Project;

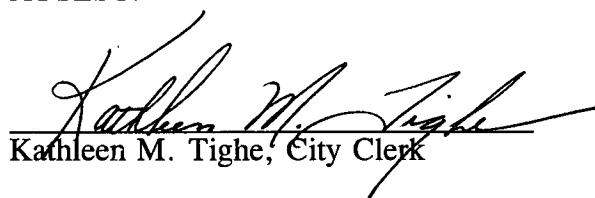
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Las Vegas, Nevada shall, when determining the labor relations policy for the construction, alteration, or repair of each project, undertaken by the City, give controlling consideration to the use of a Project Labor Agreement for each such project to the extent that such Project Labor Agreement does not violate federal, state or local laws; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that after such consideration of the use of Project Labor Agreements for specific Public Projects, successful Contractors and Subcontractors, agree to become signatory to and abide by the provisions of the Project Labor Agreement negotiated between the Project Manager and the Southern Nevada Building and Trades Council. No party may negotiate a Project Labor Agreement which contains provisions which would result in a violation of federal, state or local laws.
