**RESOLUTION NAMING THE NORTHWEST AREA OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS
(NORTH OF CHEYENNE AVENUE) "CENTENNIAL HILLS"**

WHEREAS, in recent years the northwest area of the City of Las Vegas has grown rapidly and continues to do so; and

WHEREAS, as a result of that growth, the area has developed characteristics and an identity which distinguish the area from other parts of the City; and

WHEREAS, to continue to refer to the area as the "Northwest Area" or the "Northwest Sector," although accurate, does not adequately recognize or draw attention to the characteristics and identity of the area; and

WHEREAS, a number of other distinctive areas and communities within the Las Vegas Valley have been able to maintain and celebrate their identities by bearing distinctive names; and

WHEREAS, the process of seeking and establishing an appropriate name for a distinctive community has served to increase the involvement of those who live or work in the community, and

WHEREAS, the process of seeking and establishing an appropriate name for this particular community has encouraged, and in the future will encourage and increase, the type of community pride that so many in the area already exhibit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to recognize the characteristics and identity of that portion of the northwest area of the City located north of Cheyenne Avenue, and to encourage the maintenance of those characteristics and identity by giving the area an appropriate name; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of its objectives and after taking into account the input of those who live and work in the area, the Council has selected, as the appropriate name for this area, "Centennial Hills."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS as follows:

1. That portion of the City of Las Vegas located north of Cheyenne Avenue is hereby named "Centennial Hills." That area currently consists of the area bounded by Cheyenne Avenue (on the south), Decatur Boulevard (on the east), Moccasin Road (on the north) and Puli Road

(on the west).

2. The City, through its officers and employees, shall use the name "Centennial Hills" in referring to the area described above.

3. The general public and other agencies and entities are encouraged to use the name "Centennial Hills" to refer to the area so described.
