

RESOLUTION NO. R-42-2001

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 458 (LAKE MEAD BOULEVARD); APPROVING THE FIFTH ASSESSMENT LIEN APPORTIONMENT REPORT WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN LOTS AND PARCELS OF PROPERTY WITHIN SAID DISTRICT; AND DIRECTING THE RECORDATION OF SAID REPORT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Las Vegas (Hereinafter the "City Council" and the "City", respectively), in the County of Clark and State of Nevada, has taken the requisite legal action that is preliminary to, and in the creation of, "City of Las Vegas, Nevada, Special Improvement District No. 458 (Lake Mead Boulevard)" (hereinafter the "District"), consisting of two (2) separate and distinct assessment units, for the purposes of providing for the installation of street paving, "L" type curb and gutter, sidewalk, commercial driveway approaches, street lights, water laterals, sewer laterals, water distribution main, and drainage facilities (hereinafter the "Project"), and of defraying the entire costs and expenses of the Project, by special assessments, against the assessable lots and parcels of property within each assessment unit of the District according to the benefits that would be derived from the Project by the respective lots and parcels that were to be so assessed, all in accordance with the provision of Chapter 271 et seq., of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS" herein) that provide therefor; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, pursuant to NRS 271.425, has directed the City Treasurer of the City (hereinafter the "City Treasurer") to apportion, on an equitable basis, the uncollected and heretofore unapportioned amounts of the special assessments that were levied upon that certain lot and parcel of property situated within the District and identified by the Clark County, Nevada, County Assessor's parcel number as Parcel

138-23-701-001, among the several parts into which said Parcel, has been divided and to prepare, submit and file with the City Clerk of the City (hereinafter the "City Clerk") a report of such apportionment; and

WHEREAS, the City Treasurer, on the 18th day of April, 2001, filed with the City Clerk a copy of his report of such apportionment that is entitled "Fifth Assessment Lien Apportionment Report for City of Las Vegas, Nevada, Special Improvement District No. 458 (Lake Mead Boulevard)"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed that Report and has found the same, in all respects, to be satisfactory;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, at this regular meeting thereof being held on this 18th day of April, 2001, as follows:

SECTION 1. That certain document entitled "Fifth Assessment Lien Apportionment Report for City of Las Vegas, Nevada, Special Improvement District No. 458 (Lake Mead Boulevard)", a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A" hereto, is hereby approved and adopted as and for the City's plan for the apportionment of the uncollected and heretofore unapportioned amounts of the special assessments that were levied upon that certain lot and parcel of property that is situated within the District and is identified by the Clark County, Nevada, County Assessor's parcel number as Parcel 138-23-701-001, among the several parts into which said Parcel, has been divided.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to record in the Office of the County Recorder of Clark County, Nevada, a copy of said

Report, together with a statement that the current payment status of any of the assessments that are shown thereon may be obtained from the City Treasurer.

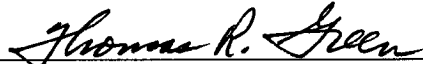
SECTION 3. That all resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution be, and they hereby are, repealed.

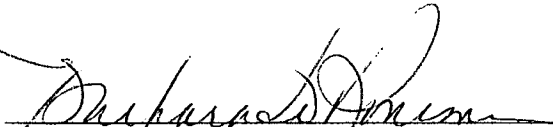

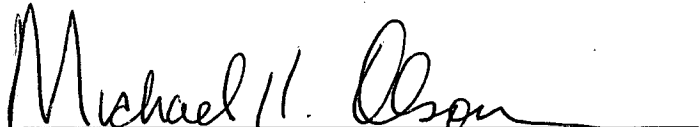
