**RESOLUTION CREATING A TRAFFIC SIGNAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS
ADVISORY COMMITTEE IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE CITY'S
TRAFFIC SIGNAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLAN**

WHEREAS, NRS Chapter 278B permits the City to impose an impact fee for the purpose of financing certain capital improvements necessitated by and attributable to new development, including traffic signalization as part of street projects.

WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS 278B.150 the City must establish a Traffic Signal Capital Improvements Advisory Committee to perform various functions related to the implementation of a capital improvements plan and imposition of an impact fee in furtherance of the said plan; and

WHEREAS, the City has established a capital improvements plan for traffic signalization; and

WHEREAS, the City Traffic and Parking Commission, consisting of nine voting members, are charged with analyzing and providing recommendations to the City Council with respect to proposed changes in traffic and parking regulations, as well as requesting the preparation and publication of traffic reports; and

WHEREAS, due to their familiarity with traffic related issues, City staff recommends that the members of the City Traffic and Parking Commission serve also as the membership of the Traffic Signal Capital Improvements Advisory Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, that the current members of the Traffic and Parking Commission be and hereby are designated as the Traffic Signal Capital Improvements Advisory Committee. As members of the Traffic and Parking Commission are replaced due to term expiration, or for other reasons, so shall the membership of the Traffic Signal Capital Improvements Advisory Committee change accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Traffic Signal Capital Improvements Advisory Committee's jurisdiction and authority granted by this Resolution be and hereby is limited

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1 to those responsibilities enumerated in NRS 278B.150 as they pertain to the City's capital
2 improvements plan for traffic signalization.

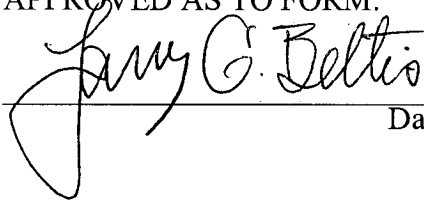
