RESOLUTION FIXING PARKING METER FEES

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas operates, for the benefit of the public, parking meters on City streets and within parking lots owned or operated by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City is constructing and will construct parking structures for the benefit of the public generally and the benefit of the City's customers and employees;

WHEREAS, the parking structures will include metered parking spaces that will allow the City to recover a portion of its costs in providing parking spaces throughout the City; and,

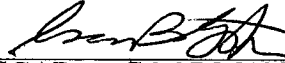
WHEREAS, in view of the above, the City Council desires to adopt a resolution to fix the maximum amount of the fees chargeable for parking at the various meters throughout the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS that:

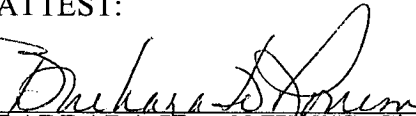
1. The fees for parking at the various parking meters on City streets, and within parking lots and parking structures owned or operated by the City, are fixed at a maximum of \$1.50 per hour.
2. The City Manager shall have the authority to establish the actual fees to be charged for parking at the various metered spaces within the City.
3. This Resolution shall be effective as of September 30, 2002.
