

RESOLUTION NO. R-108-2002**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE ADVISORY QUESTION REGARDING
FAIR SHARE FUNDING FOR TRANSPORTATION**

WHEREAS, in 1991 the Nevada Legislature adopted recommendations of Advisory Ballot Question #10; and,

WHEREAS, a Regional Transportation Commission Community Coalition (RTC3) was recently appointed to study the challenges of transportation and air quality in Southern Nevada; and,

WHEREAS, the RTC3 concluded that air quality will deteriorate to unacceptable levels unless additional transportation and air quality programs are implemented; and

WHEREAS, the RTC3 concluded that congestion on the valley roadways will rapidly deteriorate to levels worse than Los Angeles unless additional transportation capital and operational programs are implemented; and,

WHEREAS, in 2001 the RTC3 recommended a fair share funding program to generate \$2.7 billion over 25 years from additional revenues from taxes or fees on developers, aviation fuel, retail sales, and a reallocation of existing local funding; and,

WHEREAS, it is desired to have the voters of Las Vegas express their opinion on the proposed fair share funding program;

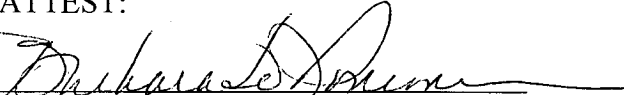
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Las Vegas is in support of passing the Fair Share Funding Advisory Question.
