**RESOLUTION REESTABLISHING A TRAFFIC SIGNAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS
ADVISORY COMMITTEE IN CONJUNCTION WITH
THE CITY'S TRAFFIC SIGNAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLAN**

WHEREAS, NRS Chapter 278B permits the City to impose an impact fee for the purpose of financing certain capital improvements necessitated by and attributable to new development, including traffic signalization as part of street projects.

WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS 278B.150 the City must establish an Advisory Committee to perform various function related to the implementation of a capital improvements plan and imposition of an impact fee in furtherance of the said plan; and

WHEREAS, the City has established a capital improvements plan for traffic signalization; and

WHEREAS, the impact fees imposed pursuant to the City's traffic signalization capital improvements plan will affect the residential and commercial building industries, and it has been proposed that those industries be represented on the Advisory Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, that the Traffic Signal Capital Improvements Advisory Committee is hereby reestablished.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the membership of the Traffic Signal Capital Improvements Advisory Committee be composed of nine members, including two or more representatives from the residential and commercial building industries. Members of the Committee shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Traffic Signal Capital Improvements Advisory Committee's jurisdiction and authority granted by this Resolution be and hereby is limited to those responsibilities enumerated in NRS 278B.150 as they pertain to the City's capital improvements plan for traffic signalization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution R-34-2002 adopted by the City Council on June 5, 2002, pertaining to the creation of a traffic signal capital improvements advisory committee composed of a different membership than provided for herein, be

Committee consisting of the membership of the City Traffic and Parking Commission is hereby dissolved.
