1RESOLUTION REGARDING THE ACCEPTANCE OF
2GIFTS AND DONATIONS TO THE CITY

3WHEREAS, from time to time the City receives offers from individuals, companies
4and other organizations to donate money, property or services to the City; and

5WHEREAS, the City Council historically has made it a practice to consider the
6acceptance of larger gifts or donations by means of an item on the City Council agenda; and

7WHEREAS, the Council desires to establish a written procedure for considering the
8acceptance of gifts or donations that have been offered to the City; and

9WHEREAS, for purposes of Paragraphs 1 and 2 of this Resolution, the term "gift"
10includes a gift or donation of money, property or services; a gift or donation of property or services
11given in-kind; and a gift or donation of property or services that is made on a temporary basis,
12including a gift or donation of the use of property or services.

13NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
14OF LAS VEGAS as follows:

151. Except as provided in Paragraph 2, the acceptance by the City of any gift shall be at
16the discretion of the City Council. Consideration of accepting the gift shall be made in connection
17with an item on the City Council agenda.

182. The City Manager has the authority to accept administratively:

19(A) Any gift of money in an amount that does not exceed \$25,000.

20(B) Any gift of property or services whose estimated fair market value does not
21exceed \$25,000.

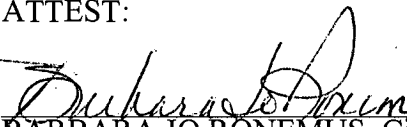
1 (C) Any gift of air time by broadcast media for public service announcements,
