**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS TO REVISE
ITS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PLANNING AND
IMPLEMENTATION PROCESS**

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas receives Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development for the purpose of benefiting low and moderate income persons, or eliminating slum and blight, or meeting an urgent need; and,

WHEREAS, the City has designated Census Tracts 3.01, 3.02, 35, (West Las Vegas) 4, 6, 7, 8, 5.03, 5.04, (East Las Vegas) and 11 (Meadows Village) as the Targeted Census Tracts and which also meet the Housing and Urban Development criteria for area benefit; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Las Vegas has designated Census Tracts 3.01, 3.02, 35, 5.03, 5.04, and 11 as blighted as defined by NRS 279.388; and at a later date will designate Census Tracts 4, 6, 7, and 8 as blighted;and,

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas is committed to utilizing CDBG funds in a manner which yields the maximum benefit to the residents of and business owners in the Targeted Census Tracts.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Las Vegas finds it to be in the best interest of the City to revise its CDBG planning and implemented process in three (3) areas;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED AND DECLARED AS
FOLLOWS:

1. A Neighborhood Improvement Plan (NIP) shall be developed and adhered to for each Targeted Census Tract area, and all CDBG funds shall be spend in accordance with the NIP; and,

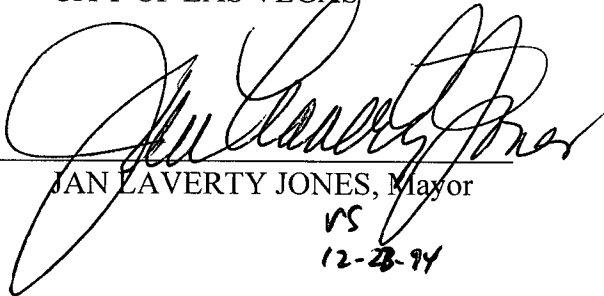
2. The current application process is hereby eliminated and replaced by a Request for Proposal only for those public services identified as needed by the NIP; and,

3. The Citizens Advisory Review Board is hereby eliminated and replaced by a citizen participation process that requires one (1) public hearing at the beginning of the program year and one (1) public hearing at the completion of the program year.
