

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS COMPREHENSIVE
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas (City) may be subjected to disasters generated by human or natural causes; and

WHEREAS, the City has the capability, which, if used effectively in an emergency, will maximize the preservation of life and property; and

WHEREAS, a comprehensive emergency management plan would enable the City to utilize its emergency response capabilities; and

WHEREAS, acting under the authority of the Federal Civil Defense Act of 1950 (Public Law 81-920), as amended, the Federal Emergency Management Agency, requires states and local entities participating in the Federal Emergency Management Assistance Program for emergency management to have an emergency management plan; and

WHEREAS, the State of Nevada and the City are participants in the Federal Emergency Management Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of NRS, Chapter 414, and Title 2, Chapter 30, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, the City Council is authorized and empowered to establish a comprehensive emergency management plan for civil defense and emergency operations in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is required to approve the City of Las Vegas Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, that the City Council hereby

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approves the attached City of Las Vegas Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan dated September, 1992.
