

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE GOVERNOR, CONSIDERATION
OF THE DESIRES OF CERTAIN CITIZENS OF THE CITY
OF LAS VEGAS TO CHANGE THE NAME OF FLOYD R. LAMB STATE
PARK TO TULE SPRINGS STATE PARK

WHEREAS, in the decade of the 1970's, the City sought to transfer by donation title to Tule Springs Park to the State of Nevada for use as a state park; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1, et seq, of Chapter 453, Statutes of Nevada 1977, the state land registrar was authorized to ". . . accept title to those portions of sections 3, 4 and 9, township 19 south, range 60 east, M.D.B. & M., known as Tule Springs Park from the City of Las Vegas, on behalf of the administrator of the state park system for development as a state park . . ."; and

WHEREAS, following the transfer of Senator Floyd R. Lamb Park to the state, the park became known as Floyd R. Lamb State Park; and

WHEREAS, of recent date citizens of the City of Las Vegas have petitioned the City Council to consider returning the name of Floyd R. Lamb State Park to Tule Springs State Park; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is devoid of authority to re-name Floyd R. Lamb State Park to Tule Springs Park because the park is not owned by the City or within the City's jurisdictional control; and

WHEREAS, those citizens favoring a name change have no effective recourse through the legislative process to have their desires collectively heard as one voice; and

WHEREAS, a change of the name of the park is of such



significant concern that it affects the community at large; and

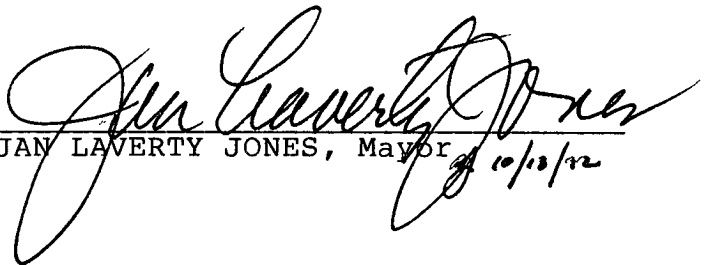
WHEREAS, the City Council believes it has a duty to assist those citizens favoring a name change to make their wishes known to the state;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Las Vegas that the Honorable Robert J. Miller, Governor of the State of Nevada, receive this resolution and be advised that this Council and certain citizens of the City of Las Vegas desire to change the name of Floyd R. Lamb State Park to Tule Springs State Park and that the Honorable Governor refer this resolution to the appropriate state agency or a designated representative thereof for further consideration of the question of whether or not such a name change should be effectuated.

THE FOREGOING RESOLUTION was approved this 6th day of October, 1992, by the following vote.
