SUPPORT FOR THE CONCEPT OF PRIVATIZATION OF
GOVERNMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas supports the concept of privatization and pledges to continue the current proactive approach by the City Council, management and staff; and

WHEREAS, privatization has been included as a key element in the City's strategic plan and made a goal and objective for each department; and

WHEREAS, during these times of fiscal constraints, the City of Las Vegas has increased its awareness of privatization opportunities as a cost effective method to provide government services; and

WHEREAS, in this fiscal year, the City of Las Vegas has increased privatized and contracted services by nearly 100% over the last fiscal year and did so without displacing any existing employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Las Vegas that we reaffirm our support for the concept of privatization of government services and a process to review and evaluate any new or expanded services for their potential for privatization and competitive bidding.

- That we will continue to investigate current services that have potential for cost savings through privatization and private sector involvement.

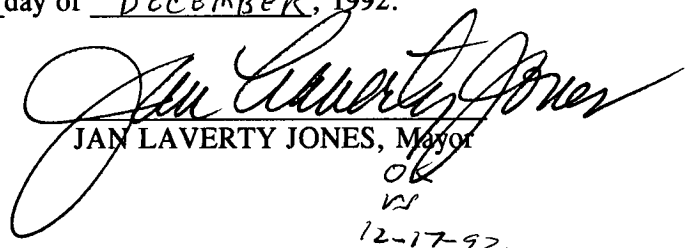
- That we will continue our active participation and cooperation with the Las Vegas Chamber of Commerce privatization committee to achieve the goal of a more cost effective government.
