

**RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION R-26-2003,
WHICH ESTABLISHED A JUDICIAL SELECTION COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, from time to time vacancies occur in the office of municipal judge on the Las Vegas Municipal Court before the expiration of a term; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter provides that such vacancies are to be filled by a vote of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2003, the City Council adopted Resolution R-26-2003, which established a committee to review applications of those who desire appointment to the Municipal Court and to recommend to the City Council the names of those the committee believes the Council should consider for appointment; and

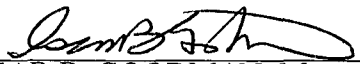
WHEREAS, the committee, although it has been constituted, has not had occasion to perform its functions; and

WHEREAS, it is the sense of the City Council that the process of reviewing applications for judicial vacancies that might occur can and should be undertaken by the Council and that the committee is not needed at the present time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS to repeal Resolution R-26-2003.
