TO SUPPORT THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A LAS VEGAS
INTERNATIONAL TRADE CENTER IN SOUTHERN NEVADA

WHEREAS, world trade is growing at a rapid rate in the United States marketplace; and

WHEREAS, international trade is a growing segment of the United States economy; and

WHEREAS, Southern Nevada has geographical advantages as a gateway to the growing Pacific Basin markets which contain at least half of the world's population; and
