

RESOLUTION OF APPROVAL BY THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS
FOR THE LOCATION AND DESIGN OF A
FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY HIGHWAY

WHEREAS, the provisions of NRS 408.100 declare in general terms the policy of the legislature of the state of Nevada and state that for the preservation of the public safety and the promotion of the general welfare, the improvement and development of transportation facilities in the state is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of NRS 408.290 provide that the department may supplement the state highway system by establishing new routes into or in the vicinity of municipalities and metropolitan areas with the approval of the board of county commissioners of the county in which such additions may be proposed and with the approval of the city council of any incorporated city directly affected thereby, if the department determines such additions to be necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has proposed a new route in the county of Clark and city of Las Vegas along a general alignment as shown on the map attached hereto, and more particularly described as a portion of a federal-aid secondary highway known as SR 159, Blue Diamond Road in Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, more particularly described as follows: Situate, lying and being in the City of Las Vegas and the County of Clark, State of Nevada, and more particularly described as being State Route 159, Blue Diamond Road, more fully described as follows, to wit:

SR 159 from the intersection of SR 159 with State Route 160 northwesterly, northerly, northeasterly and easterly a distance of approximately 21.76 miles to an intersection with Rainbow Boulevard;

and



WHEREAS, the department has held public hearings pertaining to the location and design of the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the improvement of a portion of said highway as hereinbefore described will be of material benefit to the residents of the City of Las Vegas and Clark County and to the public in general by providing a better and safer means of transportation because of such improvement.

This resolution of approval is effective as to the proposed location and design of the federal-aid secondary highway insofar as the city has jurisdiction thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the city commission of the city of Las Vegas, that pursuant to the said NRS 408.290 hereinbefore mentioned, approval is hereby given to the location and design of the hereinbefore-described federal-aid secondary highway.
