COMPUTER SCIENCE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NEVADA LAS VEGAS

WHEREAS, the growth and prosperity of Southern Nevada depends upon
economic diversification and attraction of industry to our valley; and

WHEREAS, the type of industry most desired is one which is
environmentally clean, economically stable and of the high technology variety;
and

WHEREAS, several high-tech companies are interested in Southern Nevada,
due to climate, tax structure, land availability and proximity to major
Southwest markets; and

WHEREAS, these same companies are being recruited by other Southwestern
cities with similar qualities; and

WHEREAS, it is acknowledged that other major Southwestern cities have
superior work force capabilities, due to the availability of high technology
training in engineering and computer sciences; and

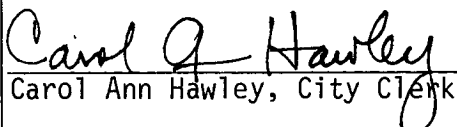
WHEREAS, Southern Nevada must upgrade its educational offerings in the
