

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas has established flood control as a citywide priority; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Las Vegas and their neighbors in the surrounding communities of Clark County have been severely impacted over the years by flooding incidents which have resulted in loss of life and millions of dollars in property damage; and

WHEREAS, the construction and maintenance of critically needed flood control facilities would require multi-million dollar investments beyond the capability of any single government; and

WHEREAS, flooding is a countywide problem which may only be solved with the on-going cooperation of all local governments; and

WHEREAS, the 1985 Nevada Legislature enacted AB 169 which made major changes in the Nevada Flood Control District Law; and

WHEREAS, AB 169 authorizes a board of county commissioners in a county whose population is 250,000 or more to impose a property tax or a sales tax of not more than 0.25 percent for support of a flood control district upon approval of the selected funding method by the electorate; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Clark County Flood Control District (District) has recommended, and the Board of County Commissioners of Clark County has selected the 0.25 percent sales tax as the preferred funding method for support of the District; and

WHEREAS, approval of imposition of the 0.25 percent sales tax will be sought from the voters of Clark County at a districtwide election to be held September 2, 1986.

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the City Council of the City of Las Vegas do hereby resolve to support approval of the ballot question authorizing the imposition of up to a 0.25 percent tax on retail sales in Clark County for
