

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS,
2 NEVADA, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE
3 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,
4 FOR A GRANT UNDER THE URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION ACT OF
5 1964, AS AMENDED, FOR INTERIOR FURNISHINGS IN THE DOWNTOWN
6 TRANSPORTATION CENTER

7 WHEREAS, the Secretary of Transportation is authorized to make
8 grants for mass transportation projects; and

9 WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain
10 obligations upon the applicant, including the provision by it of the local
11 share of project costs; and

12 WHEREAS, it is required by the United States Department of Transpor-
13 tation in accord with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of
14 1964, that in connection with the filing of an application for assistance
15 under the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended, the applicant
16 give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act
17 of 1964 and the United States Department of Transportation requirements there-
18 under.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of
20 Las Vegas, Nevada:

21 1. That the Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, is authorized
22 to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Las Vegas with
23 the United States Department of Transportation, to aid in the financing of
24 Interior Furnishings in the Downtown Transportation Center.

25 2. That the Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, is authorized
26 to execute and file with such application an assurance or any other document
27 required by the United States Department of Transportation effectuating the
28 purposes of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

29 3. That the City Manager of the City of Las Vegas, working in
30 coordination with the Director of the Regional Transportation Commission, is
31 hereby designated as agent to act on behalf of the Mayor of the City of Las
32 Vegas in furnishing such additional information as the United States Depart-
ment of Transportation may require in connection with the application of the
project.



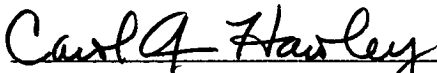
1 4. That the City Manager of the City of Las Vegas, working in
2 coordination with the Director of the Regional Transportation Commission, is
3 hereby designated as an agent on behalf of the Mayor of the City of Las Vegas
4 and is authorized to set forth and execute affirmative minority business pol-
5 icies in connection with the project's procurement needs.

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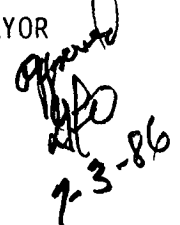
