

RESOLUTION REAFFIRMING THE CITY'S
COMMITMENT TO AIR QUALITY

WHEREAS both the residents of and visitors to the Las Vegas Valley deserve and have come to expect a quality of life which offers safe, healthy and clean living conditions; and

WHEREAS the Las Vegas Valley has experienced tremendous population growth and economic progress during the past decade; and

WHEREAS one of the most significant issues facing local governments across the nation is the ability to adequately address the maintenance and enforcement of air quality standards prescribed by state and federal law; and

WHEREAS we believe that a reauthorization of the Clean Air Act is crucial to our ability to effectively address air pollution problems within our community; and

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Las Vegas is in full support of the on-going efforts of Clark County, through the Environmental Policy Quality Review Board, and the Air Pollution Division, as well as the Department of Motor Vehicles and all other applicable agencies relative to the development and implementation of emission control, and other ambient air quality standards; and

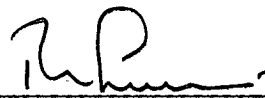

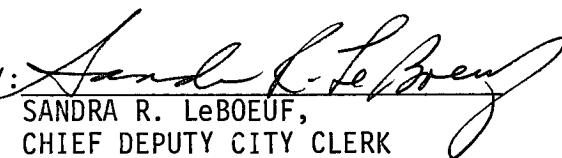
