

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ANTI-DRUG PROGRAM FOR
THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOWNTOWN TROLLEY SERVICE

WHEREAS, it has been decreed by the United States Federal Government that recipients of United States Department of Transportation financial assistance shall take all necessary and reasonable steps to carry out the provisions delineated in Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 653-Control of Drug Use in Mass Transportation Operations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas, Downtown Trolley Service, is a primary recipient of the United States Department of Transportation financial assistance; and

WHEREAS, Title 49 C.F.R. Part 653 states that if a recipient uses and/or is a public, private, contracted or other service provider in accomplishing mass transportation operations, the regulation affects these service providers; and

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas operates a Downtown Trolley Service; and

WHEREAS, Title 49 C.F.R. Part 653 states that it is the responsibility of the recipient to ensure compliance with the regulation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Las Vegas, hereby adopts an:

Anti-Drug Program in accordance with Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 653, designed to detect the use of prohibited drugs by sensitive safety employees from using prohibited drugs; and

accomplishing mass transportation operations financed in
