

R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION, CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, ADVISING THE NEVADA CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION OF THE IMPORTANCE OF A VETERANS HOSPITAL AS A PLANNING OBJECTIVE IN CONSONANCE WITH THE CONTINUED GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT OF SOUTHERN NEVADA.

WHEREAS, Nevada's population increased by 71% during the past decade making Nevada the fastest growing state in the Union; and

WHEREAS, Southern Nevada's growth rate exceeded that of any other area in Nevada; and

WHEREAS, the population growth of Southern Nevada, in general, and Clark County, in particular; is expected to continue to increase; and

WHEREAS, over 50% of Nevada's veterans currently reside in Southern Nevada and the anticipated increase in veterans will be commensurate with the anticipated accelerated growth rate of the general population.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, the City Commission, City of Las Vegas wishes to advise the Nevada Congressional Delegation that a Veterans Hospital for Southern Nevada is an important community planning objective.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, the City Commission, City of Las Vegas fully supports the efforts of Nevada's American Legion to obtain a Veteran's Administration Hospital for Southern Nevada.
