R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, it has been called to the attention of the Board of City Commissioners that the traffic congestion at the intersections of Second Street and Stewart Avenue and East Charleston Boulevard and Main Street will be greatly increased upon the completion of the interstate freeway system; and

WHEREAS, the interchanges at the above-named streets will produce a heavy flow of traffic into and out of the downtown area; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated traffic increase on Main Street and Las Vegas Boulevard upon the completion of the freeway will require an additional north-south artery to adequately serve and handle the traffic load; and

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas is presently in the process of improving the east-west streets of Stewart, Ogden, Carson and Bridger under the downtown assessment district; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and feasible to widen that portion of Second Street between East Charleston Boulevard and Bonanza Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Board of City Commissioners deem it advisable and appropriate at this time to plan and coordinate the downtown assessment district with the secondary highway system of Clark County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, that said Board go on record as requesting the County Commissioners of Clark County to include that portion of Second Street between East Charleston Boulevard and Bonanza Avenue as a part of the secondary highway system of Clark County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be entered in the official records of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada.
