10 Las Vegas, Nevada, said Board would act upon a resolution reciting the  
11 character of the necessity and authorizing a temporary emergency loan in  
12 the sum of \$25,000.00; and

13 WHEREAS, said Board of Commissioners did meet at the time and  
14 place specified, to-wit: on the 27th day of June, 1952 at the hour of 7:30  
15 o'clock P.M. on said day in the Council Chambers in the City Hall in Las  
16 Vegas, Nevada; and

17 WHEREAS, said Board unanimously adopted a resolution reciting the  
18 existence of a great emergency and necessity for a temporary loan of \$25,000.00  
19 and in which resolution a temporary loan in said amount was unanimously auth-  
20 orized for the purpose of meeting the necessity and emergency existing; and

21 WHEREAS, pursuant to the resolution last abovementioned, a certi-  
22 fied copy thereof was forwarded to the State Board of Finance of the State  
23 of Nevada for its approval; and

TO MAKE TEMPORARY EMERGENCY LOAN

WHEREAS, It being made to appear to the satisfaction of the State  
Board of Finance, duly called and met in session under and pursuant to  
the provisions of that certain Act of the Legislature of Nevada entitled  
"An Act Regulating the Fiscal Management of Counties, Cities, Towns,  
School Districts and other Governmental Agencies," approved March 12,  
1917, as amended, that a great necessity or emergency has arisen in the  
County of Clark, State of Nevada, and that necessity now exists for  
authorizing the obtaining of a temporary loan by and on the part of the  
Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada for the purpose  
of meeting such emergency as expressed in and shown by the preamble and  
resolution unanimously adopted at a meeting of said Board of Commissioners  
duly called and held on the 27th day of June, 1952, authorizing a tempo-  
rary loan for the purpose set forth in said resolution, a duly certified  
copy of which is now on file and of record in the office of the State  
Board of Finance; and

WHEREAS, It further appearing that notice of intention to adopt  
said emergency resolution was duly published according to law; therefore,

5 (\$25,000.00) Thousand Dollars as in said resolution set forth and auth-  
6 orized, be and the same is hereby approved; and be it further

7 RESOLVED, That a duly certified copy of this resolution be trans-  
8 mitted by the Secretary of the State Board of Finance to said Board of  
9 Commissioners of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada in order that the same  
10 may be recorded in the minutes of the meeting of said Board of Commis-  
11 sioners, as provided by law.

12 which certified copy was upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously  
13 carried by the said Board of City Commissioners, ordered to be recorded in  
14 the minutes of this Board of City Commissioners; and

15 WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners being authorized to make an  
16 emergency loan in the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to  
17 meet the emergency set forth in the resolution by this Board adopted at its  
18 meeting held on the 27th day of June, 1952, as aforesaid.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Manager and City  
20 Comptroller make a temporary loan as provided in the Emergency Resolution  
21 of June 27, 1952; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that when said Emergency loan has been  
23 made, a report be filed with this Board.
