

RESOLUTION NAMING CITY PARK

1 WHEREAS, it has been called to the attention of the Board of
Commissioners that the Las Vegas City Park should be named in honor of
2 some local citizens; and

3 WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners acknowledges that it has long
been the custom of cities and towns to name parks and other important
4 land marks after the names of citizens who have served long and honorably
for the benefit of the community; and

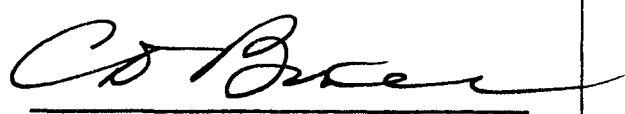
5 WHEREAS, it is common knowledge in the City of Las Vegas that
6 Mr. and Mrs. C. P. Squires have for many years resided in the City of
Las Vegas and have been ardent boosters and given unstintingly of their
7 time to the betterment and advancement of the community since its founding;
and

8 WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Commissioners to honor
9 such long and faithful service; and

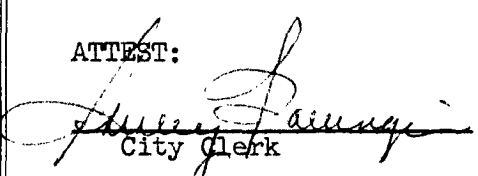
10 WHEREAS, a petition has been presented by the Mesquite Club and
some of its members thereof requesting that such recognition be given;

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the
12 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, at a regular meeting held on the 20th of January,
1954, that the name of the City Park located between Second and Fifth
13 Street and Mesquite Avenue and Bonanza Road be and it shall hereafter be
known as "SQUIRES PARK", and shall be so posted and marked on all of the
14 maps of the City and shall be known by that name hereafter.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be spread
on the Minutes of the Meeting of the Board of Commissioners and that a
16 copy of said Resolution be forwarded to Mr. and Mrs. C. P. Squires and
the Mesquite Club.
