

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS APPROVING THE
APPLICATION FOR LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUNDS
CHARLESTON RAINBOW PARK

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas proposes to submit an application to the Nevada State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for financial assistance under the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965, 78 Stat. 897 (1964); and

WHEREAS, the Nevada State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources has been assigned the administration of the program within the state, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application by local agencies under the program; and

WHEREAS, said Federal Act and adopted procedures established by the state require that the applicant must certify by resolution the approval of proposed park projects, applications and availability of local matching funds prior to submission of said applications to the state; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Charleston-Rainbow Park Acquisition Project is consistent with the Nevada State Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan, and other prerequisites of the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act;

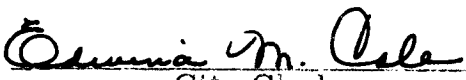
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, at a regular meeting thereof held on the 3rd day of July, 1968, that the proposed Charleston-Rainbow Park Acquisition Project is approved for implementation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Las Vegas does hereby certify that said agency can finance 100% of its share of the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Las Vegas does hereby appoint Gene Amberg, Supervisor of Federal Aid Programs - Planning Department, as agency of the City of Las Vegas to conduct all negotiations which may be necessary for the completion of the above project.

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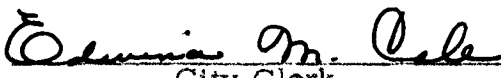
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
